

# Parish Ministers' Formation Program



PMFP is a six-month adult faith formation program for all those seeking to learn more about their Catholic faith, especially those who feel called to grow in discipleship and service.

PMFP is a basic-level adult faith formation program in which you will learn more about:

- Prayer
- The art of theological reflection
- Scripture
- The meaning of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection in our lives
- Our role in the Church today

## WHO CAN ATTEND?

All adults who desire to learn more about their Catholic faith are invited to join us! We especially encourage those serving in parish ministries or Catholic schools and those active in other Catholic organizations and movements to enroll.

## HOW ARE CLASSES OFFERED?

Classes meet weekly online. Course materials, including resources, discussion forums, and personal reflections are managed through the Schoology app. All who enroll are taught how to use this platform.

## WHEN DO I START?

The Diocese offers PMFP at least twice a year, beginning in late summer and again at the beginning of the new year. Find upcoming start dates and course information on the MFI website [www.mfisbdiocese.org](http://www.mfisbdiocese.org) and click on the PMFP tab.

## HOW MUCH DOES THE PROGRAM COST?

This six-month program costs \$220 per student—only \$10 per session! The parish, Catholic school, or Catholic organization to which you belong is encouraged to contribute \$80 toward the total cost. However, those who enroll can pay the total themselves.

We strongly recommend completing the courses in the following order:

1. Beginning the Journey  
Orientation
2. Experience of God  
(5 sessions)
3. Jesus of Nazareth  
(5 sessions)
4. The Church Continues the  
Mission of Jesus  
(5 sessions)
5. Disciples for the Kingdom  
(5 sessions)
6. Called to Serve Mini-Retreat
